

Job offers

A potential employer could make you a job offer in a number of ways:

1. Via your Media Contacts consultant – this is the most common way.
2. In a face to face situation at the end of your second / third interview.
3. By phone after the interview process is complete.
4. Via email

All of these may precede a formal offer letter / contract. Always keep your consultant up to date with how you feel about each company – it is their job to mediate on your behalf.
